

Save Cresthill Path Park and the trees that line Piedmont Park's eastern edge



Cresthill Path Park is a beautiful Woodland area, home to hardwood trees and a variety of wildlife. **It features a pervious pathway for much needed pedestrian and bicycle access to Piedmont Park.**

This woodland area (including 150 mature trees here and adjacent) and the pathway will be *entirely* destroyed and replaced by the proposed Mason/Tramell-Crow 39 story towers.

Not yet tallied: the loss of trees and greenspace involved in the construction of multistory residential and commercial developments proposed for the parklands behind **Amsterdam Walk** and the **Dutch Valley** community.
